- Have experience in lighting desk operation and programming (Apex and Gio).
- Have technical experience gained in a performance venue, including preparation, rigging, and focusing of lighting fixtures.
- Be comfortable and able to work at height, on ladders and Tallescope.
- Have knowledge of health and safety issues relating to backstage work.
- Have up to date knowledge of lighting equipment and live performance technology.
- Have some knowledge and experience of video / projection playback.
- Have a flexible approach to work and working hours.
- Be able to work well as part of a team whilst having a good ability to self-motivate and use their own initiative.
- Be able to work to deadlines.
- Be a clear and articulate communicator.
